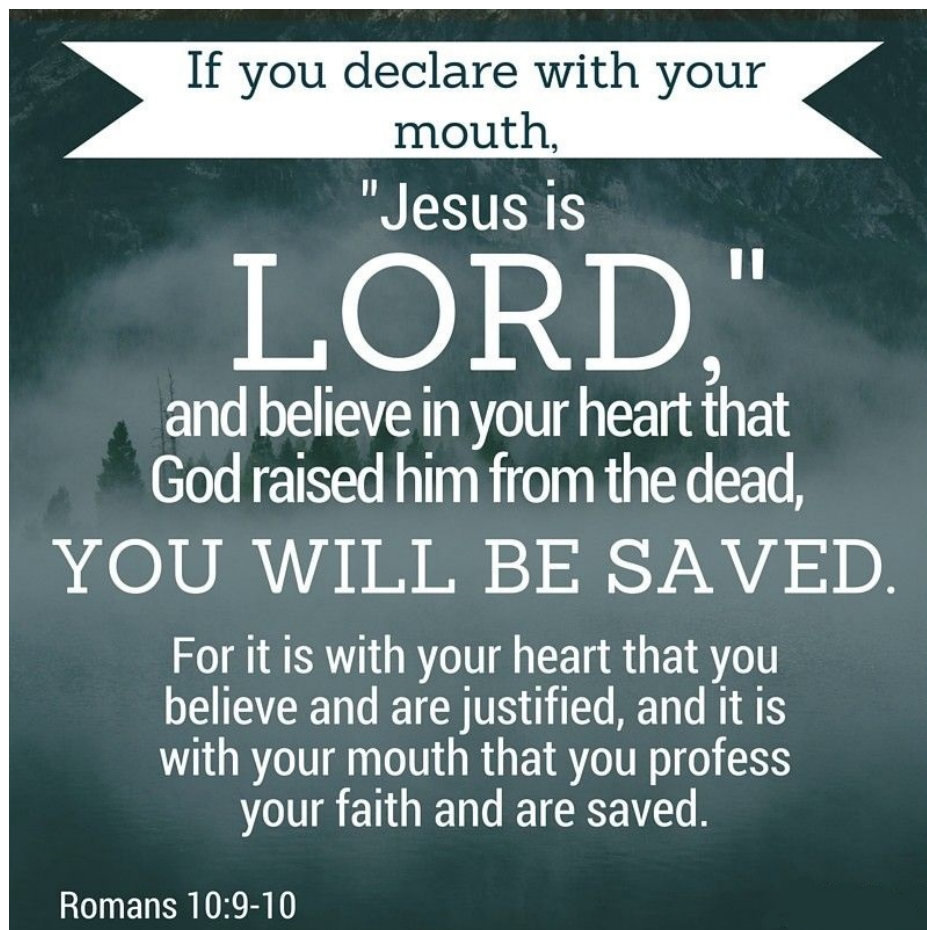
Conclusion: Gods Gives Eternal to:
